Cleaning duty.

If you are unable to attend on your designated date for any reason, please contact another club member to make arrangements for your duty day to be covered and notify your partner of the change.

Procedure for accepting public bookings

Note – If 4 or more rinks are already booked (matches, internal Club events, occasional Monday/Tuesday evenings, competitions) or expected to be in use (Friday Mixed Triple afternoons), it is acceptable to say that there is not a spare rink.

Bedford Borough Council has discontinued the Bowls Line and instead has placed the telephone number of a designated club member(s) on the notice board to the entrance of each green. It is now likely that Warwick Holden will receive any calls. He will then arrange a member to sort out bookings. Having said that, we have had no bookings in the last five years!

It is suggested that, if convenient, in the event that a member of the public wishes to make a booking Warwick passes on the details to the relevant Committee member for that week (or any available committee member) so direct contact can be made. Intending players are required to give 48 hours notice.

The relevant Committee member is requested to contact the intending players to confirm details of the booking; with you as the contact should they wish to alter the details or to cancel the booking.

Check that intending players are aware of the Council fees for bowling – see below.

Remind intending players that they should have suitable footwear.

Explain that an adult must accompany players under the age of 18 and that youngsters must be at least 10 years old (the bowls available would not suit younger children).

Find out if the intending players are all ladies.

Arrange for one of the two members on call for the date of the booking (or another member if neither are available) to supervise the booking. If the intending players are all ladies, arrange for a lady member of the Club to be present as well.

If you accept a booking for a date outside your rota week, tell the Committee member whose rota week includes that date.

Enter the booking in the Club diary.

In the event of bad weather

Advise the intending players that play is not possible.
